The participation in the mentioned lecture will be estimated for each advocate as 8 (eight) academical hours of retraining.

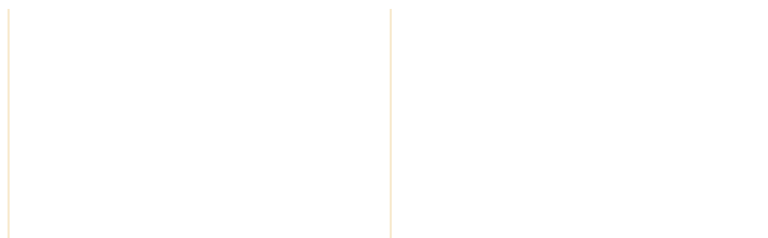
